Inauguration Day is a federal holiday in Washington D.C., and parts of Maryland and Virginia, but only for


the people that are scheduled to work that day. D.C. public schools have off that day as do local colleges.


The Agricultural, Consumer, and Environmental Science plays a role in the national and the international research initiatives in biological, physical, social, and economic sciences.
