## These items are NOT ACCEPTABLE:

UPDATED: Medicine "BOTTLES"

Prescription or OTC are no longer

on the acceptable list.

the actual drink "BOTTLES" (bottles are a different kind of plastic than the caps)

any Cap with a Silicon Lining (from chemicals/cleaners, this would include some bleach and motor oil caps)

"Pumps & Trigger Sprayers" (soap/lotion pumps, they may be plastic, but they have pieces inside them that are not acceptable)

"Fast-Food Drink Lids" (these are the wrong type of plastic. This includes fast-food cup lids & coffee drink lids, as well as the lids from deli itemà at Wal-Mart)

"Bags"

(Plastic Ziplock bags or Grocery Bags. We appreciate that you donate your caps in them, but the bags themselves do not get recycled into the benches)

Any "Food" Container (even if the plastic recycle number is a 2, 4 or 5)

K-Cups, Straws, Medical Supplies, plastic pieces that are not a lid/cap
