Second Grade

- ❖ 1 bottle Elmer's glue or 3 glue sticks (clear or white)
- ❖ 2 zipper bags for crayons and pencils
- ❖ 2 Rulers - 1 for school and 1 for home
- ❖ Erasers
- ❖ 4 highlighters (different colors)
- ❖ Pencils - lots! (Ticonderoga only)
- ❖ 2 red pens
- ❖ 1 pair of scissors, metal and pointed
- ❖ 1 box of 24 crayons
- ❖ 1 box of markers
- ❖ 1 box of Kleenex
- ❖ 4 Expo Wide tip dry erase markers
- ❖ 2 spiral notebooks
- ❖ 1 ream of copy paper
- ❖ 1 cheap drawing book (optional if your child likes to draw in his/her spare time)
- ❖ 4 good-quality folders - 2 to keep empty for use as privacy during tests, 1 to keep extra work in that is kept at school, and 1 for homework to go home in and return each day. Label the 2 for tests with name and test, label with name and school and 1 with name and home.
- ❖ 1 zip-lock bag of money for math - It should contain 6 quarters, 10 dimes, 10 nickels, and 20 pennies.
- ❖ 1 set of headphones for computers in a Ziploc bag with name on bag
- ❖ 1 pair of gym shoes to be left at school
- ❖ 1 backpack

*Please put crayons, scissors and glue sticks in one pencil bag

*Please put pencils and erasers in the other pencil bag

*Markers can be put in a ziplock bag

Trapper-keepers or personal pencil sharpeners
