Dear Parents/Guardians,

The State of Illinois has certain requirements that **must** be met in order for your Kindergarten student to attend school. Please have these exams/documents completed and ready for registration or by the first day of school. <u>If he or she is not in compliance by October 15th, your child can no longer attend school until the requirements are met.</u>

Physical Exam:

- 1. The 2015 version of the **Certificate of Child Health Examination** form <u>must</u> be completed. We cannot accept any other form.
- 2. Parents are required to complete, sign, and date the Health History section of the physical.
- 3. On the Physical Exam Requirements physician's portion of the form, the Height, Weight, BMI, B/P, Diabetes Screening, and LEAD Screening portions must be completed, along with the rest of the physical.

Immunization requirements:

- 1. Proof of Polio, DTaP, HIB, Hep B, MMR, Varicella (Chicken Pox), and Pneumococcal vaccines are needed.
- 2. The Immunization form must be signed and dated by a physician.
- 3. If your child has had Chicken Pox, written documentation from provider is needed.
- 4. If your child is not vaccinated, a medical/religious form must be completed.

Lead screening:

All students under the age of 6 entering school for the first time must have 1 lead screening. This means the Lead Questionnaire must be completed **AND** since we live in a high risk zip code, our students **MUST** have the lead screening performed (which usually consists of a finger stick). We will need the results of that finger stick. If your child had a lead screening at an earlier age, we would need the results of that screening. Make sure it is signed and dated by a healthcare professional.

Birth Certificate:

Our school district requires a copy of the certified birth certificate for each student.

Eye examination:

An eye examination is required to be done by a licensed optometrist on the Illinois Eye Examination Report Form.

Dental examination:

A dental examination is required for all students entering kindergarten and completed on the **Proof of School Dental Examination Form**. MAKE APPOINTMENTS EARLY. **This is due by May 15, 2020.**
